This Fund Raiser Vishmitha Magic Rathriyak 2 was held on 12th November at the Vijaya Kumarantungha Hall, Wadduwa presented by the Sri Lanka Magic Circle in association with Mr.A. Wijesinghe. This was held for the second consecutive year in the presence of a fairly large and appreciative local audience.

A great effort was displayed by the area organizer Mr. Wijesinghe. Mr.Rohan Jayasekera directed the performances. The local audience spontaneously applauded every act of all the performers, gleefully appreciating the mind boggling acts during the two and a half hour presentations and went home with sweet memories.



**Alex Perera** has undergone an eye operation. Hope you will have a better vision of SLMC!



FPENCIL




You have, beforehand cut out a little window in the box. This allows you to see the name of the card you are about to show!
